

Some English technical terms definition:

Browser:

Is a program to connect to remote computers, open and transfer files, display text and images and provides an uncomplicated (simple) interface.

Spreadsheets:

Are program used to analyze, organize and graph numeric data and information stored in workbooks containing worksheet.

Word processor:

Allow you to create, edit, save and print text-based documents including flyers, letters and records.

Upload:

To transfer file from a private computer to a web server.

A username:

It is the name used for identification purposes.

Virus:

Is a harmful software program that can reproduce (copy) itself.

Website:

Is a collection of WebPages on the World Wide Web (www).

Cursor:

It's a blinking line on a computer screen that shows the location of the next position.

Wireless Internet Access: (sometimes referred to as a "hot spot")

(Is a local area network (LAN) run by radio waves rather than wires.)

Email:

It is message delivered electronically from one computer to another.

Facsimile:

It is an exact copy of piece of paper sent to another location by scanning.

Internet:

It is a network of inter-connected computers.

Privacy:

The state of being alone, not watched (tracked) or bothered by others.

Attachment:

Is the other noun of documents of computer file. (generally this term is used to distinguish files that are attached with an email).

Capacity:

The amount of something that can be contained.

Out of action:

(Is the state of being inactive, absent, disabled, lazy, not engaged or sleeping on a computer network)
